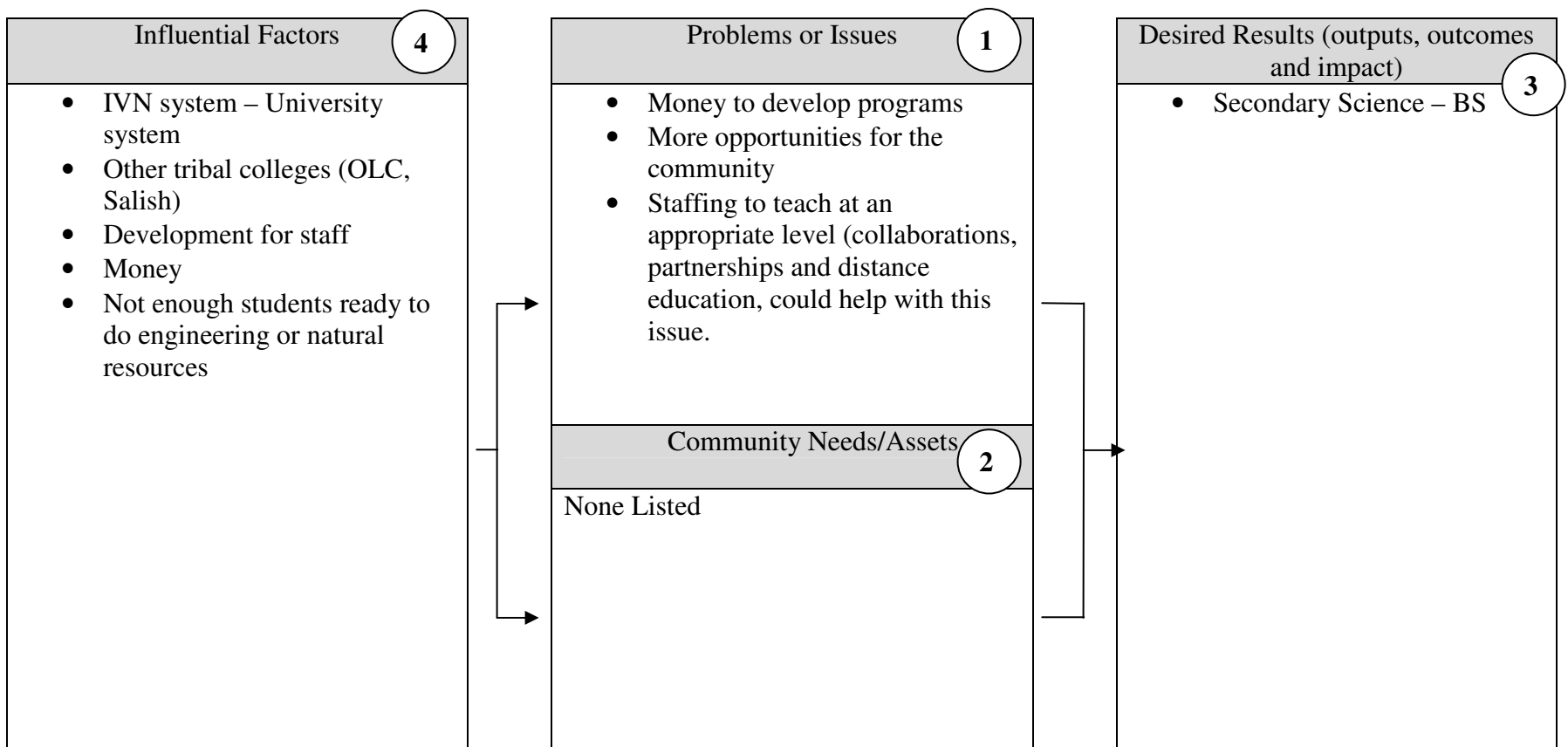

The plan for creating a 4 year degree in Tribal Studies was the only plan developed. Listed below are the items discussed in the HLC Planning Meeting on May 26, 2005 that have yet to be completed.

NOTES: Regarding the Engineering program – not enough students to complete the higher math levels.

- 4 year degrees in Business
- More Staff
- 4 year degrees in Tribal Studies
 - Start with a two year degree first
- Criminal Justice
- 4 years program Natural Resources/Environmental Science (USDA Grant – funding for next 2 years)
 - Dollars in grant for Program develop towards 4 year degree and establish partnerships.
 - Right now about 2-3 students to take w/some in the community if offer 4 year degree.
 - Start with emphasis in BIO etc. to bring students in
- 4 year program in Elementary Education
- Masters in CIS/Computers (at a standstill recent w/ANSLAMP grant)
- Collaboration with TMCC (secondary science)
